The **HISTORY** of the Mound House begins with the **CALUSA** Indians who built the shell **MOUND** and lived there beginning 2,000 years ago. Later, **CUBAN** fisher folk used the mound for camping while catching and processing fish to bring back to Cuba. The **GILBERT** family homesteaded on the shell mound and was the first to own land on Fort Myers Beach in 1894. In 1906, the **CASE** family built the first part of the Mound House which is the oldest building remaining on Fort Myers Beach. Captain Jack **DELYSLE** expanded the house in 1921. In the 1940s, the **JAMES** Foundation conducted scientific research at the Mound House including experiments with concentrate orange juice. The **LONGs** were the last family to own the Mound House before the Town of Fort Myers Beach bought the property in 1999.
